

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Determination Number 4 of 1998

Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973

1. The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the rate of remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. Part 1 amends the Tribunal's existing Determination by providing for a loss of tenure allowance for the Public Service Commissioner of 20% while the position is occupied by Ms H Williams.
3. Part 2 inserts the remuneration rates for the Chairperson and Members of the Australian Industry Development Corporation which were omitted from the Principal Determination.
4. The retrospective application of this Determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.
