

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

### Determination Number 18 of 1998

#### Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973

1. The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the rate of remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. Part 1 preserves the categorisation of office-holders for travelling allowance purposes.
3. Part 2 adjusts salaries of Departmental Secretaries, following a review.
4. Part 3 adjusts the salary for the Chief Executive Officer of Customs similarly.
5. Part 4 adjusts the salaries for most other full-time public office-holders in the same way, and preserves the categorisation of office-holders for office-holder Supplement purposes.
6. Parts 5, 6, 7 and 8 adjust the salary for Chief Executive Officer of the Film Finance Corporation, Chief Executive Officer of the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organization, Chief Executive Officer of the National Office of the Information Economy, and Director of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority, respectively.
