

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Determination Number 19 of 1998

Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973

1. The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the rate of remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. Clause 1, 2 and 3 of this Determination set the rate of basic salary, travelling allowance and skills and responsibility allowance for David Michael John Bennett QC, holder of the office of Solicitor-General, following a review of the office by the Tribunal.
3. Clause 4 of this Determination provides the basic rate of salary, travelling allowance and skills and responsibility allowance for the office when held by an acting Solicitor-General.
