Determination Number 23 of 1998

RECREATION LEAVE FOR CERTAIN FULL TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

Pursuant to sub-section 7(3AA) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the recreation leave entitlements of full-time office holders and determines as follows:

1. Determination No 33 of 1994, as amended, is referred to as the Principal Determination.
2. Paragraph (ii) of PART A of the Principal Determination is amended to read:

“On the first day of January in each year, commencing on the first day of January 1995, there shall accrue to each relevant officer a recreation leave credit which the relevant officer would have if that officer were an officer of the Senior Executive Service of the APS with entitlements within the terms of clauses 4.1 to 4.28 (inclusive) and clause 4.66 of Public Service Determination 1998/5 as in force from time to time, and those provisions applied, mutatis mutandis, to that officer, except that”
3. Paragraph (iii) of PART A of the Principal Determination is amended to read:


“in relation to the period of appointment of a full-time Judicial Registrar of the Family Court who was appointed before 10 December 1991, a reference in subclause 4.10(1) of Public Service Determination 1998/5 as in force from time to time to a period of 4 weeks were a reference to a period of 6 weeks.”
4. The following paragraph (iv) is inserted in PART A of the Principal Determination:

“Clauses 4.19, 4.20, 4.21 and 4.22 of Public Service Determination 1998/5 (annual leave deeming provisions) do not apply to leave credits accrued by public office holders holding the offices as follows whether the credits accrued before or after the person became the holder of that office:

Chief Executive Officer, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander
Commission
Auditor-General for Australia
Australian Statistician
Chief Executive Officer of Customs
Chief of the Defence Force
Commissioner of Taxation
Public Service Commissioner”.


