

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Determination Number 23 of 1998

Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973

1. The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the rate of remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. Clause 1 specifies the Principal Determination for the purposes of this Determination.
3. Clauses 2 and 3 of this Determination bring the recreation leave entitlements of full-time office holders whose entitlements are determined by the Remuneration Tribunal into line with those applying in the Senior Executive Service of the Australian Public Service through Public Service Determination 1998/5. Public Service Determination 1998/5 replaces 1983/10 which has been repealed.
4. Clause 4 of this Determination removes the application of the annual leave deeming provisions for the public office holders holding the offices specified.
