MEMBERS OF THE PARLIAMENT – REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES



Pursuant to sub-sections 7(1) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the allowances to be paid out of the public moneys of the Commonwealth to members of the Parliament by reason of their membership of the Parliament or by reason of their holding particular offices, or performing particular functions, in, or in relation to, the parliament or either House of the Parliament, has inquired into certain entitlements, being matters significantly related thereto, and, notwithstanding Clause 2 of Schedule 3 of the *Remuneration and Allowances Act 1990*, determines as set out hereunder:


1. Determination 20 of 1998, as amended, is referred to as the Principal Determination.
2. The Principal Determination is further amended by:
 - (a) deleting from Clause 1 '18 December 1998' and replacing it with '26 February 1999';
 - (b) inserting in Clause 1 the words 'or, in the case of a new electorate, from the date of the election until 26 February 1999,' after '26 February 1999';
 - (c) deleting from Clause 8 'sixth day of January 1999' and replacing it with 'twelfth day of March 1999';
 - (d) deleting from Clause 14 'Economy' and replacing it with 'Technology'; and
 - (e) replacing all references to the 'Department of Communications and the Arts' with the 'Department of Communication, Information Technology and the Arts' and all references to the 'Minister for Communication and the Arts' to the Minister for the Arts and the Centenary of Federation'.
