MINISTERS OF STATE - SALARY ADDITIONAL TO THE BASIC PARLIAMENTARY SALARY

The Honourable the Minister for Finance and Administration.

Pursuant to sub-section 6(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the question whether any alterations are desirable in the salaries payable to Ministers of State out of the public moneys of Australia, and other matters significantly related thereto. The Tribunal reports to the Minister that the rates per annum of salaries payable to Ministers of State should be as set out hereunder, from 17 October 1998:

Prime Minister	123,309
Deputy Prime Minister	80,009
Treasurer	65,209
Leader of the Government in the Senate	65,209
Leader of the House	57,869
Other Ministers in Cabinet	53,919
Other Ministers	43,136


2. The Deputy Prime Minister when acting Prime Minister should be paid at the same rate per annum of salary payable to the Prime Minister.


