
MEMBERS OF THE PARLIAMENT – TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE

Pursuant to sub-sections 7(1) and 7(2) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into travelling allowances payable within Australia and conditions of payment to members of Parliament and Ministers of State, and determines as set out hereunder, with effect from 21 December 1998:

1. Determination 8 of 1998 is referred to as the Principal Determination.
2. Clause 10 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the full stop in sub-clause (h) and replacing it with a semi colon and inserting the word "and" immediately after.
3. Clause 10 of the Principal Determination is further amended by inserting the following new sub clause:
 - (i) attendance at properly constituted meetings of a Government advisory committee or task force provided that the senator or member is a member of the committee or task force.


