

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Determination Number 2 of 1999

Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973

1. The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the allowances to be paid to members of the Parliament by reason of their membership of the Parliament or by reason of their holding particular offices, or performing particular functions in, or in relation to the Parliament or either House of Parliament.
2. This Determination amends Determination Number 8 of 1998 to enable members of the Parliament to be paid travelling allowance for attendance at meetings of properly constituted Government advisory committees or task forces of which they are a member.
3. The retrospective application of this Determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.
