Determination Number 10 of 1999

MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT – ENTITLEMENTS AND TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE

1999 CONSTITUTIONAL REFERENDUM ON THE REPUBLIC ISSUE

Pursuant to sub-sections 7(1) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the allowances to be paid out of the public moneys of the Commonwealth to members of the Parliament by reason of their membership of the Parliament or by reason of their holding particular offices, or performing particular functions, in, or in relation to, the Parliament or either House of the Parliament, has inquired into certain entitlements, being matters significantly related thereto, and, notwithstanding Clause 2 of Schedule 3 of the *Remuneration and Allowances Act 1990*, determines as set out hereunder:

PART 1

MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT - ENTITLEMENTS

- 1.1 In this Part, Determination No 26 of 1998 is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 The Principal Determination is amended by inserting at the end of Clause 2.2, the following sub-clause:
 - (c) if a senator or member is a member of an advertising campaign committee appointed by the Government in relation to the 1999 constitutional referendum on the republic issue:
 - (i) a properly constituted meeting of the committee; or
 - (ii) travel for a purpose that is approved (preferably beforehand) by such a meeting and that is within the terms of reference of the committee.
- 1.3 The Principal Determination is further amended by inserting the following Clause:
 - 2.2A The entitlement in accordance with Clause 2.2 (c) takes effect on and from the date a senator or member is appointed as a member of an advertising campaign committee.

PART 2

MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT – TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE


- 2.1 In this Part, Determination 8 of 1998 is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Clause 10 of Part 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following sub-clause:
- (j) if a senator or member is a member of an advertising campaign committee appointed by the Government in relation to the 1999 constitutional referendum on the republic issue:
 - (i) a properly constituted meeting of the committee; or
 - (ii) travel for a purpose that is approved (preferably beforehand) by such a meeting and that is within the terms of reference of the committee.

2.3 Part 2 of the Principal Determination is further amended by inserting the following clause:

10A. The entitlement in accordance with Clause 10 (j) takes effect on and from the date a senator or member is appointed as a member of an advertising campaign committee.
