



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2000/04:

Remuneration and allowances for holders of public office

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, 2000/04 takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1

ALLOWANCES FOR PARLIAMENTARIAN'S EXPENSES OF OFFICE AND RELATED MATTERS

- 1.1 In this part, Determination 1998/26, as amended, is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 The Principal determination is amended by deleting Clause 10.5 and inserting the following new clause:
"10.5 The maximum amount of unused entitlement which has been provided under clause 10.3 that can be carried over from one financial year to the next financial year shall be \$25,000."

PART 2

FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination No 5 of 1999 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Part 1 of the Principal Determination is amended with effect on and from 30 March 2000 by deletion of reference to the following offices listed in Table 1:
 - (a) The Clerk of the House of Representatives;
 - (b) Principal Parliamentary Reporter;
 - (c) The Clerk of the Senate;
 - (d) Chief Executive Officer ESRA;
 - (e) Secretary to Joint House ;
 - (f) Director, Merit Protection and Review Agency;
 - (g) Member, Merit Protection and Review Agency;
 - (h) Chairperson, National Board of Employment, Education and Training (NBEET);
 - (i) Counsellor (Category 2), NBEET;
 - (j) Deputy Chairperson, NBEET;

- (k) Member, NBEET;
 - (l) Member, NBEET who is also a Chairperson of the Higher Education Council;
 - (m) Director, National Institute of Occupational Health and Safety;
 - (n) Chief Executive Officer, Office of Asset Sales and Information Technology Outsourcing;
 - (o) Supervising Scientist;
 - (p) Principal Member, Immigration Review Tribunal.
- 2.3 Under Part 4, Clause 4.1 of the Principal Determination:
- (a) \$20,000 shall be payable to Professor H Garnett, Executive Director of the Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation for the 12 month assessment period to March 2000; and
 - (b) \$15,000 shall be payable to Ms Jennifer Bott, General Manager - Australia Council for the 12 month assessment period to March 2000.

PART 3 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 3.1 In this Part, Determination No 3 of 1999 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 Part 3; Table 3 of the Principal Determination is amended with effect on and from 22 March 2000 by increasing the fees payable in respect of the Wheat Export Authority. Annual Fees for the Chair are to be increased from \$31,500 to \$58,000 a year and Annual Fees for Members are to be increased from \$18,000 to \$26,000 a year.
- 3.3 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by the addition of the following:

- 3.4 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is further amended by the deletion of existing reference to offices of the Professional Services

Review Panel.

PART 4

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER, COMMONWEALTH SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH ORGANISATION

- 4.1 In this Part, Determination No 27 of 1995 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 4.2 Under Part 2 of the Principal Determination, \$44,475 shall be payable to Dr Malcolm McIntosh, Chief Executive Officer of the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation, for the 12 month assessment period to February 2000.

PART 5

DIRECTOR OF AVIATION SAFETY

- 5.1 In this Part, Determination No 14 of 1998 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 5.2 Under Clause 2(i) of the Principal Determination, \$14,400 shall be payable to the Director of Aviation Safety for the 12 month assessment period to July 1999.
