



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Determination 2000/06: Travelling Allowance Rates

This Determination specifies the travelling allowance rates that are to apply to the following offices in the Tribunal's jurisdiction:

- (i) Judicial and Related Offices;
- (ii) Full-time holders of Public Office;
- (iii) Part-time Holders of Public Office; and
- (iv) that guide employing bodies in specifying travelling allowance rates for Principal Executive Offices (PEOs).

It comprises:

- (i) Part 1 – Statement of Purpose;
- (ii) Part 2 – Rates of Travelling Allowance;
- (iii) Part 3 – Rates of motor Vehicle Allowance; and
- (iv) Part 4 – Application.

#### **PART 1**

#### **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Determination is to:

- (i) consolidate into three "tiers" the travelling allowance rates that are to be paid to the majority of offices in the Tribunal's jurisdiction.
- (ii) set new travelling allowance rates.
- (iii) set rates of motor vehicle allowance that are to be used for the majority of offices in the Tribunal's jurisdiction.

**TIER 1 - RATES OF TRAVEL ALLOWANCE**

Tier 1	\$350	\$335	\$270	\$180

1. **Class of Travel:** Highest Available

2. **Part Payment of Travel Allowance:**

- (i) where the costs of accommodation are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$80 only shall be payable.
- (ii) where the costs of accommodation and a meal per day are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$65 only shall be payable.
- (iii) where the costs of accommodation and more than one meal per day are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$30 only shall be payable.
- (iv) where the Commonwealth meets the travel costs of a spouse or partner accompanying the office holder, an additional \$10 a night shall be payable or such other amount as is vouched as the difference between the cost of a single and double room.

**TIER 2 - RATES OF TRAVEL ALLOWANCE**

Tier 2	\$285	\$240	\$200	\$170

1. **Class of Travel:** Business Class

2. **Part Payment of Travel Allowance:**

- (i) where the costs of accommodation are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$80 only shall be payable.
- (ii) where the costs of accommodation and a meal per day are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$65 only shall be payable.
- (iii) where the costs of accommodation and more than one meal per day are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$30 only shall be payable.
- (iv) where the Commonwealth meets the travel costs of a spouse or partner accompanying the office holder, an additional \$10 a night shall be payable or such other amount as is vouched as the difference between the cost of a single and double room.

### **TIER 3 - RATES OF TRAVEL ALLOWANCE**

	Sydney	Melbourne, Brisbane, Perth	Adelaide, Darwin, Hobart, Canberra	Other than Capital City
Tier 3	\$215	\$190	\$160	\$135

1. **Class of Travel:** Economy

2. **Part Payment of Travel Allowance:**

- (i) where the costs of accommodation are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$70 only shall be payable.
- (ii) where the costs of accommodation and a meal per day are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$50 only shall be payable.
- (iii) where the costs of accommodation and more than one meal per day are not met by the office holder, travelling allowance of \$30 only shall be payable.
- (iv) where the Commonwealth meets the travel costs of a spouse or partner accompanying the office holder, an additional \$10 a night shall be payable or such other amount as is vouched as the difference between the cost of a single and double room.

### **PART 3 RATES OF MOTOR VEHICLE ALLOWANCE**

The following rates apply to all Tier 1, 2 and 3 office holders
