Determination 2000/10:

Remuneration and allowances for holders of public office

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, 2000/10 takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1 In this Determination, Determination No 5 of 1999 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2 The Principal Determination is amended by changing the following amounts for the Director, Private Health Insurance Administration Council:
 - (a) the basic rate of salary (set out in Table 1 of Part 1 of the Principal Determination) from \$87,200 to \$98,200: and
 - (b) the maximum eligible amount of performance pay (set out in Clause 4.1 and Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination) from \$10,000 to \$12,500.
