



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2000/12:

Remuneration and allowances for holders of public office

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, No 12 of 2000 takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARIES

- 1.1 In this part, Determination No 9 of 1998, as amended, is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 The Principal Determination is revoked.

PART 2 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination No 5 of 1999 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by:
 - a) deleting reference to the Director, Private Health Insurance Administration Council and inserting Chief Executive Officer, Private Health Insurance Administration Council;
 - b) deleting reference to the Director of Affirmative Action and inserting Director of Equal Opportunity of Women in the Workplace;
 - c) deleting reference to the Commissioner, Australian Competition and Consumer Commission and inserting Member, Australian Competition and Consumer Commission;
 - d) inserting the office of Chief Executive Officer, National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC), with a base salary of \$140,900, and Tier 1 travelling allowance, with effect on and from 1 September 2000;
 - e) increasing the basic rate of salary for the Deputy Ombudsman from \$119,600 to \$125,500, with effect on and from 2 August; and
 - f) increasing the basic rate of salary for the Director-General, Office of National Assessments from \$148,000 to \$157,100, with effect on and from 1 August 2000
- 2.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following footnotes:
 - a) Footnote 3 is deleted and replaced with the following:

“Mr Dennis Richardson shall receive an Office Holder Supplement of \$11,500 and a personal loading of \$8,500, with effect on and from 1

August 2000.”

b) The following footnote is inserted for the Director-General, Office of National Assessments:

“Mr Kim Jones shall receive a personal loading of \$8,500, with effect on and from 1 August 2000.”

c) The following footnote is inserted for the Chief Executive Officer, National Health and Medical Research Council:

“Professor Alan Pettigrew shall receive a personal loading of 7.5% of base salary, with effect on and from 1 September 2000.”

2.4 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following:

2.5 Under Part 4, Clause 4.1 of the Principal Determination:

a) \$12,000 shall be payable to Dr Robert Clements, Director of the Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research for the 1999-2000 financial year.

b) \$12,500 shall be payable to Dr Russell Reichelt, Director of the Australian Institute of Marine Science for the 1999-2000 financial year.

PART 3 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

3.1 In this Part, Determination No 3 of 1999 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.

3.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended with effect on and from 27 July 2000 by deletion of Footnote 1 (relating to the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority):

“A member who is the Chair of the Risk and Audit Management Committee will receive an additional \$10,000 per annum. A Member who is a member of the Risk and Audit Management Committee will receive an additional \$5,000 per annum.”

This is replaced with the following:

“A member who is the Chair of the Risk and Audit Management Committee will receive an additional \$10,500 per annum. A Member who is a member of the Risk and Audit Management Committee will receive an additional \$5,000 per annum.”

- 3.3 a) Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended with effect on and from 19 June 2000 by the addition of the following:

- b) A footnote is added for the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Board of management as follows:

"The annual fee is payable only to Ms Joanne Willmot and is limited to the life of the current Board of Management which ceases in April 2001."

- 3.4 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by the deletion of the following:

- 3.5 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by the addition of the following:

Oil Stewardship Advisory Council	\$570	\$420	Tier 1

- 3.6 Mr Des Nicholl, Chair of the Australian Dairy Corporation shall be paid a sum of \$50,000 in recognition of extraordinary work performed for The Thai Dairy Industry Co Ltd.

PART 4 JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES

- 4.1 In this part, Determination No 13 of 1999 as amended is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 4.2 In Table 1 of the Principal Determination, the following footnote is inserted to the Deputy President and Member (Full-time) of the Australian Law Reform Commission:

"A person appointed to this office on a full-time basis only before 1 October 1999 shall receive an additional annual payment of \$8,500 a year".

PART 5**RATES OF TRAVEL ALLOWANCE**

- 5.1 In this Part, Determination No 6 of 2000 is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 5.2 In Part 1 of the Principal Determination (Statement of Purpose), the following is deleted:
 "(ii) set new travelling allowance rates".
 and replaced with:
 "(ii) set new travelling allowance rates that are to be paid in conjunction with an overnight stay".
- 5.3 In Part 2 of the Principal Determination (Rates of Travelling Allowance), the following headings are deleted:
"TIER 1 – RATES OF TRAVEL ALLOWANCE"
"TIER 2 – RATES OF TRAVEL ALLOWANCE"
"TIER 3 – RATES OF TRAVEL ALLOWANCE"
 and are respectively replaced with the following:
"TIER 1 – RATES OF TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE – per overnight stay"
"TIER 2 – RATES OF TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE – per overnight stay"
"TIER 3 – RATES OF TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE – per overnight stay"
- 5.4 In Part 3 of the Principal Determination (Rates of Motor Vehicle Allowance) is amended with effect on and from 26 July 2000 by the deletion of Column 4 and the insertion of the following:
