



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Statement: Determination 2000/12

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

#### Part 1 Parliamentary Secretaries

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 9 of 1998) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 revokes the Principal Determination.

#### Part 2 Full-time Holders of Public Office

4. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 5 of 1999) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
5. Clause 2.2 deletes reference to a number of now defunct Full-Time Holders of Public Office, inserts a new Full-Time Office Holder and amends some base salaries.
6. Clause 2.3 amends remuneration for the Director-General, Australian Security and Intelligence Organisation and the Director-General of the Office of National Assessments and the Chief Executive Officer, National Health and Medical Research Council.
7. Clause 2.4 amends remuneration for the Deputy Ombudsman.
8. Clause 2.5 amends the Principal Determination in relation to the Director of the Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research and the Director of the Australian Institute of Marine Science.

#### Part 3 Part-time Holders of Public Office

9. Clause 3.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 3 of 1999) for the purposes of Part 3 of the Determination.
10. Clause 3.2 amends Footnote 1 relating to the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority.
11. Clause 3.3 makes the addition of the Australian Sports Drug Agency (receiving annual fees) and the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Board of Management to [Table 1](#).

12. Clause 3.4 deletes reference to the Australian Sports Drug Agency (receiving per diem fees) and the Committee of Review of the Employer Nomination Scheme and Labour Agreements from Table 2.
13. Clause 3.5 inserts the Oil Stewardship Advisory Council into Table 2.
14. Clause 3.6 makes a one-off payment to the Chairman of the Australian Dairy Corporation.

#### **Part 4 Judicial and Related Offices**

15. Clause 4.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 19 of 1999) for the purposes of Part 4 of the Determination.
16. Clause 4.2 makes an amendment to the remuneration for the Deputy President and Members (Full time) of the Australian Law Reform Commission.
17. Clause 4.3 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 13 of 1999) for the purposes of Part 4 of the Determination.

#### **Part 5 Rates of Travel Allowance**

18. Clause 5.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 6 of 2000) for the purposes of Part 5 of the Determination.
19. Clause 5.2 makes amendment to Part 1 of the Principal Determination.
20. Clause 5.3 makes amendment to Part 2 of the Principal Determination.
21. Clause 5.4 makes amendment to Part 3 in the Principal Determination.
