



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/02: Remuneration and allowances for various public offices and Members of Parliament

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, No 2 of 2001 takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1

FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination No 5 of 1999 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by moving the reference to the office of Director, Professional Services Review including the footnote and placing it in the table immediately following the reference to the office of the Deputy Commonwealth Ombudsman. The footnote for the office of Director, Professional Services Review will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.3 Delete all references from the Principal Determination to the following offices with effect on and from 13 December 2000:
 - (a) Director, Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research;
 - (b) Director, Australian Institute of Family Studies;
 - (c) Deputy Managing Director, Austrade;
 - (d) Director of Equal Opportunity for Women in the Workplace;
 - (e) Chief Executive Officer, Comcare;
 - (f) Chief Executive Officer, National Occupational Health and Safety Commission;
 - (g) Director, Chemicals Notification and Assessment; and
 - (h) Employment Advocate.
- 1.4 As a result of clause 1.3, sequentially renumber footnotes in Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination.
- 1.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the General Manager, Aboriginal Hostels Ltd.

Office	Basic Rate of Salary (\$)	Travel Entitlement
Renewable Energy Regulator	97,000	Tier 2

- 1.6 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Renewable Energy Regulator which reads:
 "With effect on and from 7 February 2001."
 This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.7 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by replacing the footnote with reference to the office of the Director, Professional Services Review with the following:
 "The office of the Director, Professional Services Review shall receive Base salary of \$125,500 with effect on and from 8 September 2000 and a payment in lieu of performance remuneration of \$8,500 with effect on and from 22 March 2000."
 This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.8 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the footnote to the reference to Executive Director, Australian Sports Commission. After deleting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.9 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that:
- a) the Managing Director of Frontline Defence Services, Mr Neil Walker, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$12,500 for the period ending 30 June 2000;
 - b) the General Manager of the Australia Council for the Arts, Mr Michael Lynch, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$13,090 for the period August 1997 to August 1998;
 - c) the Chief Executive Officer of the National Office for the Information Economy, Dr Paul Twomey, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$35,651 for the period 2 February 1998 to 30 June 2000;
 - d) the Chief Executive Officer of Comcare, Ms Meryl Stanton, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$4,500 for the period 1 July 2000 to 31 October 2000.
- 1.10 Part 4, Table 4.3 is amended by deleting the reference to the office of the Director, Professional Services Review.
- 1.11 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following:

PART 2**PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination No 3 of 1999 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Delete all references from the Principal Determination to the following offices:
- (a) AusIndustry Board;
 - (b) Non - Government Schools Funding Review Committee;
 - (c) Aged Care Accommodation Bond Board;
 - (d) Australian National Railways Commission; and
 - (e) National Better Health Program Management Committee.
- 2.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Quarantine and Exports Advisory Council:

Authority	Chairperson	Deputy Chairperson	Member	Travelling Allowance (Per overnight stay)
Board of General Practice Education and Training Limited	\$51,600	-	\$23,300	Tier 1

- 2.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the National Health Information Management Advisory Council:

Authority	Chairperson	Deputy Chairperson	Member	Travelling Allowance (Per overnight stay)
Marriage and Family Council	\$25,800	-	-	Tier 2

- 2.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the Board of General Practice Education and Training Limited which reads:
- "The annual fees are payable with effect on and from 30 November 2000. An additional start-up fee of \$8,300 for the Chair and \$7,700 for the Members per annum will be payable until 31 December 2001."
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 2.6 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Chair of the Marriage and Family Council which reads:
- "The Annual fee, with effect on and from 1 December 2000, of \$25,800 is to continue until the cessation of Ms Pauline Frick's appointment on 30 June 2001. At this time the remuneration will revert to the per diem fee as specified in Part 2, clause 2.5 of the Principal Determination."
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.7 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the Sydney Airports Corporation Limited (including the footnote) and inserting the following after the reference to the Commissioner for the Complaints of the Aged Care Complaints Resolution Scheme:

- 2.8 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Sydney Airports Corporation Limited which reads:

“With effect on and from 29 November 2000.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.9 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting footnote # which makes reference to the Sydney Airports Corporation Limited.
- 2.10 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee:

Indigenous Advisory Committee	\$500	\$300	Tier 2

- 2.11 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Indigenous Advisory Committee which reads:

“With effect on and from 11 October 2000.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.12 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Biological Diversity Advisory Committee which reads:

“With effect on and from 11 October 2000.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.13 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Scientific Committee on Wildlife Use which reads:

“With effect on and from 11 October 2000.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining

footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.14 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the footnote which refers to the Australian River Co Ltd and inserting the following new footnote in its place:

"Additional remuneration of \$36,500 per annum shall be payable to Mr E G Anson on a pro rata basis for the performance of executive duties for the period 1 January 2001 until 31 December 2001 if deemed necessary by the Board of the Australian River Company."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.15 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of the Australian Student Traineeship Foundation and inserting the following in its place:

Authority/Office	Chair (Rate per diem of Fee)	Members (Rate per diem of Fee)	Travelling Allowance (Per overnight stay)
Enterprise and Career Education Foundation Deputy Chair	\$570 \$500	\$420	Tier 1

- 2.16 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Enterprise and Career Education Committee which reads:

"With effect on and from 13 February 2001. The Enterprise and Career Education Foundation has Directors not Members."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.17 Part 6, Table 6 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of the Member of the Central Land Council and inserting the following in its place:

Office	Rate of Salary or Fee \$	Travel Entitlement
Member If engaged on general Council business	Not exceeding 160 per diem	Tier 2
Member If engaged on business of the Executive	Not exceeding 240 per diem	Tier 2

PART 3

JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES

- 3.1 In this Part, Determination 13 of 2000 is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 Remove all references from the Principal Determination to the Industrial Registrar effective on and from 13 December 2000.
- 3.3 Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the President, Deputy President, Senior Members and the Members of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal which reads:

"In addition to fees specified in Table 1, a part time-member shall be paid a cancellation fee equivalent to 50% of one day's fee for the cancellation of all work on a day with fewer than 5 working days'

notice."


This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 4.2 Part 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting Clauses 6C and 10A.


