



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/04: Remuneration and allowances for various full-time public offices

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, No 4 of 2001 takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1

FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination No 5 of 1999 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting footnote number 1 which makes reference to the Managing Director of the Australian Broadcasting Corporation:

"Mr Jonathan Shier shall receive a personal loading of 15% of Base Salary with effect on and from 10 July 2000."

After inserting new footnote number 1, sequentially re-number subsequent footnotes.
- 1.3 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that the Director of the Private Health Insurance Administration Council, Ms Gayle Ginnane, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$8,000 for the period ending 30 June 2000.
