



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2001/04

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

Part 1 Full-time Holders of Public Office

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (1999/05) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 inserts a new footnote into Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination which stipulates that Mr Jonathan Shier, Managing Director of the Australian Broadcasting Corporation shall receive a personal loading of 15% with effect on and from 10 July 2000.
4. Clause 1.3 specifies that the Director of the Private Health Insurance Administration Council shall receive a performance payment of \$8,000 for the period ending 30 June 2000.
