



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/05: Remuneration and allowances for various part-time public offices

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, No 5 of 2001 takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 **PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

- 1.1 In this part, Determination No 3 of 1999 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the Office of the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee and inserting the following:

Authority/Office	Chair (Rate per diem of Fee)	Members (Rate per diem of Fee)	Travelling Allowance (Per overnight stay)
Companies and Securities Advisory Committee	\$520	\$470	Tier 1

- 1.3 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a footnote to the reference to the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee:

"The per diem fee has effect on and from 29 November 2000. The Companies and Securities Advisory Committee has a Convenor not a Chair."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially
