



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2001/05

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

#### Part 1 Part-time Holders of Public Office

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (1999/03) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 increases the per diem fees for the Chair and Members of the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee to \$520 and \$470 respectively.
4. Clause 1.3 inserts a footnote into Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination with reference to the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee that stipulates that that the new per diem fees are with effect on and from 29 November 2000. The footnote also stipulates that the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee has a Convenor not a Chair.
