



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2001/09

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the allowances and matters significantly related thereto for members of the Parliament, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*. The purpose of the amendments is to provide dependent children who are over 12 and designated persons with access to the pooling and conversion provisions of Determination Number 26 of 1998. This will mean that these categories of persons are able to travel at other than economy class, provided this is done within entitlement as spelt out in the pooling and conversion provisions of the Determination.

#### **PART 1 – MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT - ENTITLEMENTS**

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination as being Determination Number 26 of 1998 (as amended).
3. Clause 1.2 specifies that clause 2.10 of the Principal Determination is to be amended to make its operation subject to clauses 2.21, 2.22 and 2.23.
4. Clause 1.3 specifies that clause 2.11 of the Principal Determination is to be amended to makes its operation subject to clauses 2.21, 2.22 and 2.23.
5. Clause 1.4 specifies that clause 2.18 of the Principal Determination is to be amended to include the additional words as set out.
6. Clause 1.5 specifies that clause 2.19 of the Principal Determination is to be amended to include the additional words as set out.
