



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2001/12

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

#### **PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (2001/06) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 deletes all references to the office of the Council for Aboriginal Reconciliation from the Principal Determination as the office no longer exists.
4. Clause 1.3 deletes the office of the Director, Chemicals Notification and Assessment from Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination as the office is a Principal Executive Office.
5. Clause 1.4 deletes the footnote associated with the Director, Professional Services Review from Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination as the office was not suitable to receive performance pay.
6. Clause 1.5 deletes the obsolete footnote associated with the Commissioner, Repatriation Commission from Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination.
7. Clause 1.6 deletes all footnotes associated with the Chief Executive Officer, National Office for the Information Economy from Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination. These footnotes related to the former Chief Executive Officer.
8. Clause 1.7 specifies that the following office holders will receive a performance bonus:
  - a) the Acting Director of the Australian Institute of Marine Science, Dr John Bell;
  - b) the Director of the National Gallery of Australia, Dr Brian Kennedy;
  - c) the Director-General of the National Library of Australia, Ms Jan Fullerton; and
  - d) the General Manager of the Australia Council for the Arts, Mr Michael Lynch.
9. Clause 1.8 inserts the office of the Chief Executive Officer, ATSIC into Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination and specifies the annual maximum level of performance remuneration payable to that office.
10. Clause 1.9 entitles the office of the Second Commissioner of Taxation to be

assessed for Level 1 pro rata performance pay for the period 1 December 2000 to 4 April 2001.

## **PART 2 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

11. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (2001/07) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
12. Clause 2.2 deletes all references to the offices of the Australian Wool Research and Promotion Organisation, Council for Sustainable Vegetation Management and Council for Aboriginal Reconciliation from the Principal Determination. These offices are being removed as they no longer exist.
13. Clause 2.3 replaces footnote 1 associated with the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority in Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination. This corrects a transposition error and reinstalls the correct audit fees.
14. Clause 2.4 inserts a footnote '#' for the Private Health Insurance Administration Council which provides for additional fees for work undertaken with Risk and Audit Management. This corrects a transposition error and reinstalls the correct audit fees.
15. Clause 2.5 changes the name of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commercial Development Corporation to Indigenous Business Australia.
16. Clause 2.6 inserts a footnote '#' into Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination for the office of Indigenous Business Australia which provides for additional fees for work undertaken with Risk and Audit Management.
17. Clause 2.7 replaces the heading row from Part 3, Table 3 of the Principal Determination with a new heading row which stipulates that the rate of fee payable to the Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and Members is from 5 April 2001 unless otherwise specified.
18. Clause 2.8 replaces the heading row from Part 5, Table 5 of the Principal Determination with a new heading row which stipulates that the part-time per diem fee is from 5 April 2001 unless otherwise specified.
19. Clause 2.9 replaces clause 7.21(b) of the Principal Determination with an updated clause.
20. Clause 2.10 replaces clause 7.27 of the Principal Determination with an updated clause.
21. Clause 2.11 corrects a typographical error by renumbering clauses 7.28 and 7.29 of the Principal Determination to 7.29 and 7.30 respectively.
22. Clause 2.12 corrects a typographical error by inserting a new clause into the Principal Determination numbered clause 7.28.

## **PART 3 JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES**

23. Clause 3.1 specifies the Principal Determination (2000/13) for the purposes of Part 3 of the Determination.
24. Clause 3.2 deletes the reference to the office of the Registrar of the Industrial Relations Court of Australia from the Principal Determination as this office no longer exists.

## **PART 4 DIRECTOR- CIVIL AVIATION SAFETY AUTHORITY**

25. Clause 4.1 specifies the Principal Determination (1998/14) for the purposes of Part 4

of the Determination.

26. Clause 4.2 increases the base salary for the Director of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority to \$148,800 per annum with effect on and from 31 March 2001.
27. Clause 4.3 specifies that the Director of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority, Mr Mick Toller will receive a performance bonus.
28. Clause 4.4 increases the additional remuneration for Mr Toller to \$54,200 per annum with effect on and from 31 March 2001.

## **PART 5 SECRETARIES OF DEPARTMENTS AND SPECIFIED STATUTORY OFFICERS**

29. Clause 5.1 specifies the Principal Determination (1999/04) for the purposes of Part 3 of the Determination.
30. Clause 5.2 replaces clause 4.7 of the Principal Determination with an updated clause to reflect that Determination 1999/05, as referred, has now been replaced by Determination 2001/06.
