



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/15: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, No 15 of 2001, takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting all references to the office of the Managing Director, Health Insurance Commission with effect on 4 May 2001.
- 1.3 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting all references to the office of the Chair, Australian Research Council with effect on 1 July 2001.
- 1.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of Executive Member, National Council for the Centenary of Federation and inserting the following in its place:

Chief Executive Officer, National Council for the Centenary of Federation	134,100	Tier 2

- 1.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of Privacy Commissioner and inserting the following after the reference to the Chief Executive Officer, Australian Maritime Safety Authority:

- 1.6 For the period 20 December 2000 to 4 April 2001, the Privacy Commissioner, Mr Malcolm Crompton, shall receive the basic salary rate of \$148,800 per annum (paid pro rata for that period), supplementary remuneration in lieu of performance remuneration of \$11,500 per annum (paid pro rata for that period) plus access to Tier 1 travel.

- 1.7 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Director, National Museum of Australia:

- 1.8 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the Chairman, Indigenous Business Australia which reads:
- “The part-time Chairman of Indigenous Business Australia, Mr Joseph Elu, shall continue to receive an annual fee of \$40,700 until such time as a full-time Chairman is appointed.”
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.9 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote number 1 to the reference to the Chair, Australian Competition and Consumer Commission which reads:
- “Professor Allan Fels shall receive a personal loading of 20% of Base Salary with effect on and from 29 January 2001.”
- After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.10 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the Chief Executive Officer, Australian Film Finance Corporation which reads:
- “The office of Chief Executive Officer of the Australian Film Finance Corporation shall receive a level of performance based remuneration of up to 15% of base salary, as specified in Table 1, paid annually with effect on and from 30 May 2000. The amount of performance remuneration to be paid is to be assessed in a manner consistent with the *Performance Remuneration Guidelines* published by the Remuneration Tribunal from time to time.”
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.11 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the Chairperson, Commonwealth Grants Commission which reads:
- “With effect on and from 25 May 2001, a part-time Chairperson of the Commonwealth Grants Commission shall receive an amount equivalent to 70 percent of the full-time annual rate of salary. The part-time Chairperson should also receive an amount equivalent to 70 percent of Supplementary Remuneration in Lieu of Performance Remuneration applicable to the office.”
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.12 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the Chairman, Superannuation Complaints Tribunal which reads:
- “For the period that Mr Graham McDonald is occupying the office of the Chairman he will be paid the remuneration and allowances prescribed in relation to the office of the Deputy President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal.”
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.13 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that:
- a) the Executive Director of the Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation, Professor Helen Garnett, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$20,000 for period 1 April 2000 to 31 March 2001; and
 - b) the Managing Director of the Special Broadcasting Service, Mr Nigel Milan, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$20,000 for the period 2 February 2000 to 1 February 2001.
- 1.14 For the period 1 December 2000 to 30 June 2001, the performance pay for the Chief Executive Officer of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission shall be assessed in accordance with Part 4 of Determination 2001/06 by the Minister for Reconciliation and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Affairs.

PART 2

PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination Number 7 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting all references to the office of the Innovative Agricultural Marketing Program Committee.
- 2.3 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting all references to the office of the Deputy Chair and Member of the Australian Research Council with effect on 1 July 2001.
- 2.4 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting all references to the office of Expert Advisory Committees of the Australian Research Council with effect on 1 July 2001.
- 2.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of the National Childcare Accreditation Council and inserting the following in its place:

National Childcare Accreditation Council	19,300	–	**	Tier 2

- 2.6 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Uluru-Kata Tjuta Board of Management:

- 2.7 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee which reads:

“With effect on and from 25 May 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.8 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the National Rural Advisory Council – Specialist Committees:

- 2.9 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the National

Childcare Accreditation Council which reads:

“With effect on and from 25 May 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.10 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Tax Agents' Board:

- 2.11 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Fuel Standards Consultative Committee which reads:

“With effect on and from 25 May 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.12 For the period 5 April 2001 to 30 June 2001, the office of Deputy Chair, Australian Research Council shall receive a per diem fee of \$440.
- 2.13 For the period 5 April 2001 to 30 June 2001, the office of Member, Australian Research Council shall receive a per diem fee of \$390.
- 2.14 Part 4 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote number 1 to the reference to office of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee which reads:
- “ With effect on and from 25 May 2001, the Chairman of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee will receive an annual fee as per Part 1, Table 1.”

PART 3 JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES

- 3.1 In this Part, Determination Number 13 of 2000 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of the Registrar of the National Native Title Tribunal including footnote number 8 and inserting the following in its place:

- 3.3 Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by re-inserting footnote number 8 to the reference to the Registrar, National Native Title Tribunal which reads:
- “A person appointed to this office on a full-time basis before 1 October 1999 shall receive an additional annual payment of \$5,750 a year.”
- After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 3.4 Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote number 16 to the reference to the Registrar, National Native Title Tribunal which reads:
- “With Effect on and from 25 May 2001.”

PART 4 DIRECTOR – CIVIL AVIATION SAFETY AUTHORITY

- 4.1 In this Part, Determination Number 14 of 1998 (as amended) is

referred to as the Principal Determination.

- 4.2 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting clause 1 and inserting the following in its place:


"Salary at the rate of \$148,800 per annum with effect on and from 31 March 2000.

(i) The amount of salary specified in this clause shall be reduced by the exact amount of any additional superannuation contributions payable by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority in accordance with superannuation arrangements approved by the Minister for Finance and Administration."


- 4.3 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting clause 3 and inserting the following in its place:

"In addition to the remuneration specified above, Mr Toller shall be entitled to additional remuneration of \$54,200 per annum with effect on and from 31 March 2000."
