



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/17: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, Number 17 of 2001, takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the references to the following offices with effect on 1 July 2001:
 - a) Chief Executive Officer, Australia New Zealand Food Authority;
 - b) Director, Australian Institute of Health and Welfare;
 - c) Chief Executive Officer, Private Health Insurance Administration Council;
 - d) Managing Director, Frontline Defence Services (AAFCONS);
 - e) Managing Director, Defence Housing Authority;
 - f) Chief Executive Officer, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission (ATSIC);
 - g) Director, Evaluation and Audit; and
 - h) Counsellor, Australian Research Council.After deleting these offices all footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of the Managing Director of the Australian Tourist Commission with effect on 5 July 2001.
- 1.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Privacy Commissioner:

Chief Executive Officer, Australian Research Council	153,000	Tier 1
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- 1.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Chief Executive Officer, Australian Research Council which reads:

“With effect on and from 1 July 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.6 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the Chief Executive Officer, National Council for the Centenary of Federation and inserting the following in its place:

Chief Executive Officer, National Council for the Centenary of Federation	134,100	Tier 1
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- 1.7 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote with reference to the travelling allowance for the office of the Chief Executive Officer, National Council for the Centenary of Federation which reads:

“Provision of Tier 1 travel entitlements has effect on and from 5 July 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.8 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Principal Member, Migration Review Tribunal which reads:

“While Mr Steve Karas OAM holds the office of Principal Member of both the Migration Review Tribunal and the Refugee Review Tribunal, he shall be entitled to receive a base salary of \$139,600 per annum, a personal loading of 15 per cent of base salary and a payment in lieu of performance pay of \$8,500 per annum.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.9 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Principal Member, Refugee Review Tribunal which reads:

“While Mr Steve Karas OAM holds the office of Principal Member of both the Migration Review Tribunal and the Refugee Review Tribunal, he shall be entitled to receive a base salary of \$139,600 per annum, a personal loading of 15 per cent of base salary and a payment in lieu of performance pay of \$8,500 per annum.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.10 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that:

- a) the Chief Executive of the National Capital Authority, Ms Annabelle Pegrum, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$15,000 for the period 1 July 1999 to 30 June 2000; and
- b) the General Manager of the Australia Council for the Arts, Ms Jennifer Bott, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$13,500 for the period April 2000 to April 2001.

- 1.11 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the references to the following offices with effect on 1 July 2001:
- a) Chief Executive Officer, Private Health Insurance Administration Council;
 - b) Managing Director, Frontline Defence Services (AAFCAANS);
 - c) Managing Director, Defence Housing Authority; and
 - d) Chief Executive Officer, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission.
- 1.12 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of the Managing Director, Australian Tourist Commission with effect on 5 July 2001.
- 1.13 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Chief Executive Officer, National Health and Medical Research Council:

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PART 2 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination Number 7 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the office of General Practice Education and Training Limited:

Australian Research Council	53,400	-	**	Tier 1
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- 2.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Chair of the Australian Research Council which reads:

“With effect on and from 1 July 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.4 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Prime Minister's Science, Engineering and Innovation Council:

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- 2.5 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Member of the Australian Research Council which reads:

“With effect on and from 1 July 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.6 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Fuel Standards Consultative Committee:

Geographical Indications Committee	500	440		Tier 2
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- 2.7 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of Geographical Indications Committee which reads:

“With effect on and from 5 July 2001.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.8 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Tax Agents’ Board:

Disciplinary Appeal Committee	540	-	Tier 2
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- 2.9 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Convenor of the Disciplinary Appeal Committee which reads:

“With effect on and from 5 April 2001, the per diem fees payable to the Convenor of the Disciplinary Appeal Committee are subject to a minimum payment of \$2,500 per annum only whilst this office exists as a result of the Public Employment (Consequential and Transitional) Regulations 1999.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.10 For the period 1 June 2000 to 4 April 2001, the Convenor of the Disciplinary Appeal Committee shall be entitled to receive per diem fees in the amount of \$520. These fees are subject to a minimum payment of \$2,500 per annum.

- 2.11 Part 3, Table 3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Forest and Wood Products Research and Development Corporation which reads:

“With effect on and from 1 May 2000, a Member of the Forest and Wood Products Research and Development Corporation, in addition to his or her annual fee, shall receive a per diem fee of \$520 when conducting the business of the National Timber Development Council or the Hardwood Research and Development Advisory Body. The per diem fee is to be paid in accordance with the provisions of Part 2 of this Determination. Travelling allowance will be at the Tier 2 rate.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 3. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 3 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.12 Part 4 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the office of the National Drugs and Poisons Schedule Committee into the list of Professional Committees - Health and Aged Care and Family and Community Services Portfolio with effect on and from 5 July 2001.

PART 3

DIRECTOR – CIVIL AVIATION SAFETY AUTHORITY

- 3.1 In this Part, Determination Number 14 of 1998 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.

- 3.2 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting clause 1 and inserting the following in its place:

“Salary at the rate of \$153,900 per annum with effect on and from

5 April 2001.

(i) The amount of salary specified in this clause shall be reduced by the exact amount of any additional superannuation contributions payable by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority in accordance with superannuation arrangements approved by the Minister for Finance and Administration."

3.3 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting clause 3 and inserting the following in its place:

"In addition to the remuneration specified above, Mr Toller shall be entitled to additional remuneration of \$56,100 per annum with effect on and from 5 April 2001."

3.4 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting Paragraph 1 and inserting the following in its place:

"Pursuant to sub-sections 8(2) and 8(3) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration to be paid to Mr Mick Toller, the holder of the public office of Director, Civil Aviation Safety Authority, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out hereunder."
