



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/18: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, Number 18 of 2001, takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the office of Director, Professional Services Review:

Gene Technology Regulator	129,800	Tier 2
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- 1.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Gene Technology Regulator, which reads:

"With effect on and from 30 August 2001.

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Sex Discrimination Commissioner, which reads:

"With effect on and from 24 September 2001, Ms Pru Goward shall be eligible to receive an additional annual payment of up to \$23,400, plus one-off connection fees for utilities. This amount can be used to meet all costs to the Commonwealth to subsidise Ms Goward for her commercial (rental) accommodation costs in Sydney and will be paid on the proviso that Ms Goward does not purchase property in Sydney. Ms Goward will be responsible for any additional costs associated with her Sydney commercial accommodation.

Ms Goward will not be eligible to access travel allowance entitlements in Canberra and/or Sydney whilst she remains eligible to receive the additional payment."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.5 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Chief Executive Officer, Australian Research Council with effect on and from 28 June 2001:

Chief Executive Officer, Australian Maritime Safety Authority	1
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- 1.6 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting all references to the following offices with effect on 17 September 2001:
- a) Principal, Australian Institute of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Studies;
 - b) General Manager, Aboriginal Hostels Ltd;
 - c) Chief Executive Officer, Australian Maritime Safety Authority; and
 - d) Chief Executive, National Capital Authority.

After deleting these offices all footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

PART 2 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination Number 7 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the Frontline Defence Services, including footnote number 19, and inserting the following in its place:

Frontline Defence Services (AAFCANS)	26,700	-	13,600	Tier 2
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- 2.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of Frontline Defence Services which reads:
- “The annual fees and travelling allowance entitlement for the Chair and Members of Frontline Defence Services is with effect on and from 7 August 2001.
- Also with effect on and from 7 August 2001, a member who is the Chair of the Audit Committee will receive an additional \$10,000 per annum and a member who is a member of the Audit Committee will receive an additional \$5,000 per annum.”
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 2.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting footnote number 4 with reference to the office of Airservices Australia and inserting the following in its place:
- “Airservices Australia Board Members who are members of the Safety and Environment Committee will receive an additional fee of \$10,000 per annum.”

- 2.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote with reference to the Member of the office of the Commonwealth Services Delivery Agency which reads:

"With effect on and from 1 July 2001, Ms Gillies shall receive an additional \$10,000 per annum whilst she continues to fill the position of Chair of Centrelink's Information and Technology Committee."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.6 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting footnote number 11 with reference to the Disciplinary Appeal Committee with effect on and from 5 April 2001. After deleting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

PART 3

JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES

- 3.1 In this Part, Determination Number 13 of 2000 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 In accordance with footnote 11 and 12 of Table 1 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that:
- a) the Chief Executive of the Family Court, Mr Richard Foster, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$21,400 for the period 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001; and
 - b) the Chief Executive Officer of the Federal Magistrates Service, Mr Peter May, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$18,100 for the period 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001.
