



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Determination 2001/19: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, Number 19 of 2001, is deemed to have come into operation on 5 April 2001.

#### **PART 1**

#### **FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 6 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting new Clause 6.15A after Clause 6.15:  
"Clause 6.15 does not apply to any additional spouse or partner accompanied travel entitlement to which an office holder specified in Table 1 was eligible upon appointment."
