



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2001/19

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (2001/06) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 inserts a new clause 6.15A after the existing clause 6.15. Clause 6.15A is intended to prevent an unintended impact of the Principal Determination on office holders with an existing entitlement to accompanied travel.
