



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2001/21

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (1999/11) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 inserts the office of Member of the Australian Securities and Investments Commission into Schedule A of the Principal Determination and specifies the Base Salary and Total Remuneration available to that office.
