



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/24: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
- (ii) This Determination, Number 24 of 2001, takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting footnote 14 with reference to the Chief Executive Officer of the National Council for the Centenary of Federation.
- 1.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the office of the Deputy President, Repatriation Commission:

- 1.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Chief Executive Officer, Australian Strategic Policy Institute, which reads:

"With effect on and from 22 June 2001."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of Director, Classification Board and inserting the following after the reference to the office of Chairman, Indigenous Business Australia:

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.9 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of Classifier, Classification Board and inserting the following in its place:

- 1.10 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Classifier, Classification Board, which reads:

"With effect on and from 1 July 2001."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.11 With effect on and from 1 December 2000 the following clauses are inserted into Part 2 of the Principal Determination directly after clause 2.3:

"2.4 For the purposes of clause 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3, a 'current office' or 'current position' includes an office or position to which the person has been reappointed.

2.5 A person who holds the office of Vice-Chief of the Defence Force, Chief of Navy, Chief of Army or Chief of Air Force is

not entitled to a loading under clause 2.1, 2.2, or 2.3 of this Determination.

2.6 A person who holds the office of Vice-Chief of the Defence

Force, Chief of Navy, Chief of Army or Chief of Air Force and is appointed to that office on or before 31 March 2001, is entitled to additional remuneration per annum of the greater of-

- (a) \$11,585; or
- (b) 50% of 15% of the Reference Salary C referred to in clause 2.2 of this Determination.

2.7 A person who holds the office of Vice-Chief of the Defence Force, Chief of Navy, Chief of Army or Chief of Air Force and is appointed to that office on or after 1 April 2001, and has held the office of Vice-Chief of the Defence Force, Chief of Navy, Chief of Army or Chief of Air Force on or before 31 March 2001, is entitled to additional remuneration per annum of the greater of-

- (a) \$11,585; or
- (b) 50% of 15% of the Reference Salary C referred to in clause 2.2 of this Determination.

2.8 A person who holds the office of Vice-Chief of the Defence Force, Chief of Navy, Chief of Army or Chief of Air Force and is appointed to that office on or after 1 April 2001, and has not held the office of Vice-Chief of the Defence Force, Chief of Navy, Chief of Army or Chief of Air Force on or before 31 March 2001, is entitled to additional remuneration per annum of 50% of 15% of the Reference Salary C referred to in clause 2.2 of this Determination."

1.12 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that:

- a) the Managing Director of Austrade, Mr Charles Jamieson, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$7,000 for period 1 December 2000 to 30 June 2001;
- b) the Director of the Australian War Memorial, Major General Steve Gower AO, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$11,250 for the period 1 July 2000 to 4 April 2001;
- c) the Chief Executive Officer of the Private Health Insurance Administration Council, Mrs Gayle Ginnane, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$10,000 for the period 1 July 2000 to 30 June 2001; and
- d) the Chief Executive Officer of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission, Mr Mark Sullivan, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$11,667 for the period 1 December 2000 to 30 June 2001.

1.13 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Chief Executive Officer, Australian Research Council:

1.14 Part 4, Table 4.3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of First

Parliamentary Counsel which reads:

“With effect on and from 1 July 2001, the Attorney-General will assess the annual amount of performance pay for this office.”

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 4.3.

- 1.15 In accordance with part 5 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that the office of the First Parliamentary Counsel shall be entitled to receive a pro-rata payment in lieu of performance pay of \$6,679 for the period of 1 December 2000 to 30 June 2001.

PART 2 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination Number 7 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the National Standards Commission:

- “The annual fee of \$49,500 is to continue until the cessation of Ms Joanne Willmot’s appointment on 31 December 2001. Remuneration for this office will revert to the per diem rates specified in Part 2, clause 2.5 of the Principal Determination on 1 January 2002.”

- 2.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting footnote number 19 with reference to the office of the Marriage and Family Council with effect on and from 1 July 2001.

- 2.6 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the Oil Stewardship Advisory Council :

DIRECTOR OF AVIATION SAFETY

- 3.2 The Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new unnumbered clause directly before clause 1 which states:
 "Determination 14 of 1998 (as amended) is repealed with effect on and from 17 September 2001."
