



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2001/26: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) The Remuneration Tribunal is empowered to inquire into and determine the remuneration and significantly related matters for holders of public office as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973.
- (ii) This Determination, Number 26 of 2001, takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this Part, Determination Number 7 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 2, Table 2, of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the General Practice Education and Training Consultative Group:

General Practice Education and Training Consultative Group	390	270	Tier 2
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- 1.3 Part 2, Table 2, of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting reference to the office of Genetic Manipulation Advisory Committee and substituting the following after the reference to the Committee Reviewing Temporary Entry of Business Personnel and Highly Skilled Specialists with effect on and from 19 November 2001:

Gene Technology Technical Advisory Committee	590	440	Tier 1
Gene Technology Community Consultative Committee	590	440	Tier 1
Gene Technology Ethics Committee	590	440	Tier 1

- 1.4 Part 2, Table 2, of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting footnote number 10 and substituting the following:

“Mr EG Anson shall receive additional remuneration of \$36,500 per annum, on a pro rata basis, for periods where he has the approval of the Board of the Australian River Company to perform executive duties.”

- 1.5 Part 3 of the Principal Determination is amended by deletion of reference to the following offices listed in Table 3 (if any):
- Australian Horticultural Corporation;
 - Horticultural Research and Development Corporation;
 - Australian Pork Corporation;
 - Australian Dried Fruits Board;
 - Pig Research and Development Corporation;
 - Australian Horticultural Corporation Selection Committee;
 - Australian Wool Industry Selection Committee;
 - Australian Pork Corporation Selection Committee;
 - Horticultural Research and Development Corporation Selection Committee;
 - Dried Fruits Research and Development Council.

PART 2

AUSTRALIAN SECURITIES INVESTMENTS COMMISSION – REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES

- 2.1 In this Part, Determination Number 11 of 1999 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Paragraph 1.1 of Part 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the definition of “Total Remuneration” and substituting the following:
- “**Total Remuneration**” is the value attributed to the remuneration to be paid to an office-holder and includes:
- salary, subject to the packaging provisions of clauses 2.3 to 2.8 inclusive;
 - the value, calculated in accordance with clauses 2.9 and 2.10, of a fully maintained Commonwealth provided vehicle plus parking and fringe benefits taxation; and
 - the value attributed by the Remuneration Tribunal to the employer’s superannuation contributions or Superannuation Support
- but does not include the Travelling Allowances specified in Part three of this Determination.
- 2.3 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting paragraph 2.10 and substituting the following:
- 2.10 Where an officer holder elects to receive a Commonwealth provided vehicle, the value of the vehicle component of the office holder’s Total Remuneration is to be the actual cost. Should the actual cost to the Commonwealth of an office holder’s vehicle component at the date of this determination exceed \$21,500 in value, the value of that office holder’s vehicle component will be taken to be \$21,500 until the expiration of the lease arrangement in place at the date of this determination.
- 2.4 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting Schedule A and substituting Schedule A at Attachment 1 with effect on and from 19 November 2001.

Part 3

SECRETARIES OF DEPARTMENTS AND SPECIFIED STATUTORY OFFICERS – REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES

- 3.1 In this Part, Determination Number 4 of 1999 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 Paragraph 1.1 of Part 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the definition of “Total Remuneration” and substituting the following with effect on and from 2 May 2001:

“Total Remuneration” is the value attributed to the remuneration to be paid to a Specified Statutory Officer and includes:

- salary, subject to the packaging provisions of clauses 3.4 to 3.9 inclusive;
- the value, calculated in accordance with clauses 3.10 and 3.11, of a fully maintained Commonwealth provided vehicle plus parking and fringe benefits taxation; and
- the value attributed by the Remuneration Tribunal to the employer’s superannuation contributions or Superannuation Support

but does not include;

- adjustment in lieu of performance bonus in accordance with clause 3.12;
- performance bonus specified in clauses 3.13, 3.14 and 3.15;
- travelling allowances and expenditure specified in Part 4;
- compensation for early loss of office provisions specified in Part 5.

The Principal Determination is amended by deleting paragraph 3.11 and substituting the following with effect on and from 2 May 2001:

- 3.11 Where a Specified Statutory Officer elects to receive a Commonwealth provided vehicle, the value of the vehicle component of the Specified Statutory Officer’s Total Remuneration is to be the actual cost. Should the actual cost to the Commonwealth of a Specified Statutory Officer’s vehicle component at 7 May 2001 exceed \$21,500 in value, the value of that Specified Statutory Officer’s vehicle component will be taken to be \$21,500 until the expiration of the lease arrangement in place at the date of this determination.

PART 4

FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE – REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES


- 4.1 In this Part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.

4.2 Part 1, Table 1, of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Chairman, Productivity Commission, which reads:


"Mr Gary Banks shall receive a personal loading of \$8,500, with effect on and from 19 November 2001."
