



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2002/01: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1

PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 7 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, Table 1, of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following footnote to the reference to the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation:

“A member who is the Chair of the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation’s Alliance and Contingent Divestment Implementation Committee will receive an additional pro-rata payment of \$6,000 per annum. A member who is a member of the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation’s Alliance and Contingent Divestment Implementation Committee will receive an additional pro-rata payment of \$3,000 per annum”.

The footnote will bear the next sequential number to the last footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote, all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

PART 2

FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 2.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting all references to the following offices with effect on 1 December 2001:
 - a) Chief Executive Officer, Australian National Training Authority;
 - b) Chief Executive Officer, Australian Research Council;
 - c) Director, Australian Institute of Marine Science;
 - d) Executive Director, Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation;

- e) Executive Director, National Standards Commission;
- f) Director, Australian National Maritime Museum;
- g) Director, Australian Film, Television and Radio School;
- h) General Manager, Australia Council;
- i) Director-General, National Library of Australia;
- j) Director, National Museum of Australia;
- k) Chief Executive Officer, Australian Film Finance Corporation Limited; and
- l) Director, National Gallery of Australia.

After deleting these offices and all footnotes to these offices, the remaining footnotes in the Principal Determination should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.3 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that the Director of the Australian Institute of Marine Science, Professor Stephen Hall, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$15,000 for the period 1 December 2000 to 30 November 2001.

PART 3

CHIEF EXECUTIVE – COMMONWEALTH SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH ORGANISATION

- 3.1 In this part, Determination Number 1 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 The Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new unnumbered clause directly below clause 1 which states:

“Determination 1 of 2001 is revoked with effect on and from 1 December 2001.”

PART 4

MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT - ENTITLEMENTS

- 4.1 In this part, Determination Number 27 of 2001 is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 4.2 The Principal Determination is amended by replacing clause 1.2 with the following:


“The Principal Determination is amended by renumbering three existing clauses. Clause 10.8 becomes 10.11, clause 10.8A becomes 10.8 and clause 10.9 becomes 10.12. The Principal Determination is further amended by inserting new clauses 10.9 and 10.10:

10.9 In respect of a financial year in which a general election is held, immediately following a general election a re-elected senator or member may call-forward up to 25 per cent of his or her Communications Allowance from the next financial year’s entitlement.

10.10 Where a senator or member calls forward an amount (an advance) in accordance with clause 10.9, the Communications Allowance entitlement for the financial year from which the advance has been drawn shall be reduced by the amount of that advance.”

4.3 This Part is taken to have come into operation on 17 December 2001.
