



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2002/01

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

#### PART 1 – PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 7 of 2001) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clause 1.2 inserts a footnote with reference to the Export Finance and Insurance Corporation's Alliance and Contingent Investment Committee. This footnote specifies additional fees payable to the Chair and members of this Committee.

#### PART 2 – FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

5. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 6 of 2001) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
6. Clause 2.2 deletes references to the offices specified in the Principal Determination. These offices are being deleted due to the offices becoming Principal Executive Offices.
7. Clause 2.3 specifies that the Director of the Australian Institute of Marine Science will receive a performance bonus.

#### PART 3 – CHIEF EXECUTIVE – COMMONWEALTH SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH ORGANISATION

8. Clause 3.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 1 of 2001) for the purposes of Part 3 of the Determination.
9. Clause 3.2 revokes Determination 1 of 2001 in full. The revocation is a result of the Chief Executive of the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation becoming a Principal Executive Office on 1 December 2001.

#### PART 4 – MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT – ENTITLEMENT

10. Clause 4.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 27 of 2001) for the purposes of Part 4 of the Determination.
11. Clause 4.2 corrects a drafting error in the Principal Determination.

12. Clause 4.3 specifies that this part will take effect from the date the Principal Determination was originally signed.
