



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2002/04

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (2001/06) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 deletes all references to the offices specified from the Principal Determination. The reasons for the deletions are as follows:
 - The National Council for the Centenary of Federation ceased to exist at the end of 2001;
 - The National Office for the Information Economy (NOIE) has been established as an Executive Agency and is no longer under the Remuneration Tribunal's determinative jurisdiction; and
 - The Office for Government Online is now part of NOIE and there is no longer an office of Chief Executive.

PART 2 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

4. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (2001/07) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
5. Clause 2.2 inserts the office of the Sydney Harbour Federation Trust into Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination and specifies the base salary and travelling allowance payable.
6. Clause 2.3 inserts a new footnote specifying the remuneration arrangements for the Members of the Sydney Harbour Federation Trust who are also Members of Sydney Harbour Federation Trusts' Audit Committee.
