



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2002/05

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

#### PART 1 – REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 15 of 2000) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clause 1.2 replaces Table 1 of the Principal Determination to reflect a 4% increase in the levels of remuneration for the offices of the Solicitor-General and the Director of Public Prosecutions with effect from and on 1 October 2001.
