



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2002/06:

Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1

FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that the Director of the Australian National Maritime Museum, Ms Mary-Louise Williams, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$18,000 for the period 1 January 2000 to 30 June 2001.
- 1.3 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that the Chief Executive Officer of the National Health and Medical Research Council, Professor Alan Pettigrew, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$10,500 for the period 1 January 2001 to 31 December 2001.

PART 2

DIRECTOR CIVIL AVIATION SAFETY AUTHORITY

- 2.1 In Determination Number 14 of 1998, the Remuneration Tribunal, pursuant to subsections 8(2) and 8(3) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, determined that the Director, Civil Aviation Safety Authority have an amount of performance based remuneration assessed in accordance with Guidelines advised by the Remuneration Tribunal from time to time.
- 2.2 The Remuneration Tribunal now determines, in accordance with the Director's right to have performance pay during the relevant period determined by the Tribunal in the manner described in clause 2 of Determination Number 14 of 1998 as then in force, that the Director, Civil Aviation Safety Authority, Mr Mick Toller, shall be paid performance based remuneration in the amount of \$12,000 for the period 1 July 2000-30 June 2001.

PART 3**JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES**

- 3.1 In this part, Determination Number 23 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 Clause C6 is deleted. After deleting that clause the remaining clauses in the Principal Determination should be renumbered sequentially.
- 3.3 The Principal Determination is amended by replacing clause C29 with the following:
"For the purposes of this Determination, Tiers 1, 2 and 3 shall correspond to the highest, middle and lowest salary levels respectively, specified in the ATO Ruling table that deals with the matter referred to in clause C28."


PART 4**TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE RATES**

- 4.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2000 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 4.2 The Principal Determination is amended by replacing clause 2(I)(c) with the following:
"Where an office holder is accommodated in private, non-commercial accommodation, such as the home of a family member or friend, a rate of one third of the specified rate is payable, rounded upwards to the nearest dollar. Where the one third rate is payable, clauses 2(ii) and 2(iii) will not apply."
