



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2002/12:
Remuneration and allowances for holder of public offices

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
(ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDER OF PUBLIC OFFICES


- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 9 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
1.2 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that:
a) the Managing Director, Special Broadcasting Service, Mr Nigel Milan, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$20,000 for the period 2 February 2001 to 1 February 2002; and
b) the Managing Director, Austrade, Mr Jamieson, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$10,000 for the period 1 July 2001 to 30 April 2002.
1.3 Part 1, Table 1, of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of 'Head of the Office of Indigenous Policy'.
1.4 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting the reference to the office of Director, Professional Services Review and inserting the following after the reference to the office of the Chief Executive Officer, Australian Strategic Policy Institute with effect on and from 5 April 2002:

- 1.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Director, Professional Services Review, which reads:
'For the period 22 March 2000 to 4 April 2002 the basic rate of salary for this office was \$138,700 a year.'
This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 2.1 In this part, Determination Number 10 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Part 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting reference to the following offices in Table 2:
- (i) Committee on Employment Opportunity;
 - (ii) Australian Information Economy Advisory Council; and
 - (iii) Home and Community Care Program Negotiating Team.
- 2.3 Part 1, Table 1, of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the Australian Institute of Marine Science, which reads:
- "A member who is chair of the Audit Committee will receive an additional \$6,000 per annum. A member who is a member of the Audit Committee will receive an additional \$3,000 per annum."
- This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 2.4 Part 2, Table 2, of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting reference to the office of the 'Corporations and Securities Panel' and inserting the office of 'Takeovers Panel' in its place.


