



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2002/14

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

#### **PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 9 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clauses 1.2 and 1.3 delete references to an office specified in the Principal Determination. The office of Managing Director, Australian Trade Commission (AUSTRADE) is being deleted following its declaration as a Principal Executive Office.

#### **PART 2 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

5. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 10 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
6. Clause 2.2 deletes references to an office specified in the Principal Determination. The office of Chairperson, Aged Care Complaints Resolution Committees has been deleted as it no longer exists.
7. Clause 2.3 deletes references to offices specified in the Principal Determination. The offices of Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and Member of Australian Defence Industries (ADI Ltd) have been deleted since ADI has been sold by the Commonwealth.
8. Clause 2.4 effects a name change to an office specified in the Principal Determination. The Australia New Zealand Food Authority is replaced with Food Standards Australia New Zealand. This Clause also determines revised annual remuneration for the Chair and Members of the Committee on and from 1 July 2002.
9. Clause 2.5 Clause 2.9 inserts a new footnote in relation to Food Standards Australia New Zealand that stipulates the date of effect of the new remuneration.
10. Clause 2.6 replaces a footnote relating to the Refugee Review Tribunal. The footnote limits the maximum fees that can be paid each year to part-time Members.
11. Clause 2.7 replaces a footnote relating to the Migration Review Tribunal. The footnote limits the maximum fees that can be paid each year to part-time Members.

12. Clause 2.8 effects a name change to an office specified in the Principal Determination. The Military Superannuation and Benefits Scheme Reconsideration Advisory Committee is replaced with the Military Superannuation and Benefits Scheme Reconsideration Committee. This Clause also determines revised per diem fees for the Chair and Members of the Committee on and from 5 April 2002.
13. Clause 2.9 inserts a new footnote in relation to the Military Superannuation and Benefits Scheme Reconsideration Committee that stipulates the date of effect of the new fees.

### **PART 3 COMPENSATION FOR LOSS OF OFFICE**

14. Clause 3.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 11 of 1992) for the purposes of Part 3 of the Determination.
15. Clause 3.2 corrects a drafting error in the Principal Determination.
