



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2002/15

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 FULL-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 9 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clauses 1.2 and 1.3 delete references to two offices specified in the Principal Determination. The offices of Associate Member, Australian Communications Authority and Member, Australian Film Commission are being deleted following the decision not to appoint any full-time members in the foreseeable future.

PART 2 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

5. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 10 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
6. Clause 2.2 replaces the per diem fee with an annual fee for the Chair, Australian Council for Children and Parenting and specifies that the annual fee has effect on and from 5 April 2002. The clause also places this office in the correct position in Part 1, Table 1.
7. Clause 2.3 inserts a new footnote in relation to the Australian Council for Children and Parenting that stipulates the period which remuneration applies for the Chair.
8. Clause 2.4 deletes the current reference to the office of the 'Australian Council for Children and Parenting' and inserts a new reference to the office of the 'Australian Council for Children and Parenting' in the correct position in Part 2, Table 2.
