



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/12

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 – JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 21 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clauses 1.2 and 1.3 increase the remuneration specified in Table 1 (Rates of Remuneration – Judicial Offices) and Table 2 (Rates of Remuneration – Non-Judicial Offices) of the Principal Determination with effect from 1 July 2003.
