



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2003/21: Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Public Offices

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to various public office holders and Members of Parliament, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 PART-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 3 of 2003 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, **Table 1A** of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the symbol '#' against the entry for the Australian Submarine Corporation Pty Ltd with effect on and from 29 May 2003.
- 1.3 Part 4 of the Principal Determination is amended by replacing the entry for the 'National Health Information Management Advisory Council' with 'Australian Health Information Council'.

PART 2 FULL-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

- 1.4 In this part, Determination Number 11 of 2003 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.5 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the entries for CEO, Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Agency and Director, Professional Services Review and inserting the following with effect from 1 July 2003:

- 1.6 Part 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting clauses 2.10 and 2.11 as follows:

'2.10 CEO, ARPANSA: For the period from 19 December 2002 to 30 June 2003 the remuneration level for the office of CEO, ARPANSA is varied to \$230,000 Total Remuneration, in lieu of that contained in Determination 2002/23.'

'2.11 Director, PSR: For the period from 19 December 2002 to 30 June 2003 the remuneration level for the office of Director, PSR is varied to \$219,000 Total Remuneration, in lieu of that contained in Determination 2002/23.'

PART 3 COMPENSATION FOR LOSS OF OFFICE

- 1.7 In this part, Determination Number 11 of 1992 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.

- 1.8 The Principal Determination is amended by inserting clause 5 as follows:

'5. Where an office holder is eligible for a payment under clause 3, the rate of remuneration used for calculating an entitlement is to be the same as the office holder's salary for superannuation purposes.'
