



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2003/22: Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Public Offices

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to various public office holders, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 PART-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

1.1 In this part, Determination Number 3 of 2003 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.

1.2 Part 1, **Table 1A** of the Principal Determination is amended deleting the entry of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority, Chair, Deputy Chair and Member.

1.3 Part 1, **Table 1A** of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the entry of International Air Services Commission, with effect on and from 14 October 2003:

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1.4 Part 1, **Table 1A** of the Principal Determination is amended by updating the entry for the Australian Sports Commission, with the following with effect on and from 14 October 2003:

Australian Sports Commission (#)	\$36,400	\$21,320	\$19,140	Tier 1
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1.5 Part 4 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the 'Professional Services Review Tribunal' from its list of Professional Committees - Health and Aged Care and Family and Community Services Portfolio.

PART 2 FULL-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

1.6 In this part, Determination Number 11 of 2003 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.

1.7 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the entry for Member, SSAT and inserting the following with effect on and from 14 October 2003:

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1.8 Part 3 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting clause 3.1 and all its sub-clauses and associated Table 3A and replacing them with the following, with effect on and from 1 July 2003.

3.1 Accommodation Allowance: The Office Holders listed in Column 1 of Table 3A will be eligible to receive an accommodation allowance (subject to expenditure) as shown in Column 3 of Table 3A whilst they occupy the office shown in Column 2. This amount is to assist the Office Holder in meeting settling-in and commercial rental accommodation costs (including one-off utility connection costs) in the office location:

- (a) while they also continue to have a property other than in the office location, as their principal place of residence; and
- (b) it will not be paid for such periods that they live in premises owned by them at the office location.

An Office Holder will not be eligible to access travel allowance entitlements in the home locality or the office locality whilst they remain eligible to receive the accommodation allowance.

Where the commercial accommodation does not include cooking facilities, the cost of meals may form part of the payment, within the accommodation cap set for an Office Holder.

3.1.1 Transitional: This provision applies in respect of the accommodation allowances for Mr M Keelty, Mr G Clark and Mr T Wilson. Where the terms and conditions applying to the allowance immediately prior to being prescribed in a Remuneration Tribunal Determination (ie at 18 December 2002) differ from the above clause, the former provisions will apply to the extent of any inconsistency.

3.1.2 Limitations: The allowance payable to Mr R Jones will reduce to \$13,000 from 1 July 2004 and cease on 1 July 2005.

3.1.3 Classification Board: The employer may approve reimbursement of accommodation expenses for Members of the Classification Board in accordance with agency policy, based on the Rates of Contribution and Rental Ceilings specified in the DEWR Allowance Subscription Scheme.


3.1.4 Defence Chiefs: The employer may approve housing assistance in accordance with agency policy and practices for the Vice-Chief of the Defence Force, the Chief of Navy, the Chief of Air Force and the Chief of Army.

- 1.9 Part 3 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting clause 3.2 and associated Table 3B and replacing them with the following, with effect on and from 1 July 2003.

'3.2 Reunion Travel: The Office Holders shown in Column 1 of Table 3B may receive travel costs of up to the amount shown in column 3 from their employer for travel back to their principal place of residence for the purposes of family reunion while they continue to occupy the office shown in Column 2.'


