



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2004/06

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 – FULL-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 9 of 2002) for the purposes of this part of the Determination.
4. Clause 1.2 specifies that the Chief Executive, National Capital Authority, will receive a performance bonus.

PART 2 – PART-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

5. Clause 1.3 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 3 of 2003) for the purposes of this part of the Determination.
6. Clause 1.4 re-instates a provision whereby Board members of Medibank Private Limited receive audit committee fees with effect on and from 18 December 2003.
7. Clause 1.5 reflects a name change from 'Commission for Safety, Rehabilitation and Compensation of Commonwealth Employees' to 'Safety, Rehabilitation and Compensation Commission'. The fees remain unchanged.
