



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2004/07 Parliamentary office holders – Additional salary

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the additional salary for parliamentary office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*. The Tribunal has decided that no change should be made to the levels of additional salary.

PART 1 – GENERAL

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the date of effect of the determination and administration matters. Clause 1.1 states that this Determination revokes Determination 2003/05 in full.

PART 2 – ADDITIONAL SALARY AND RELATED MATTERS

3. Clause 2.1 specifies the basic salary for the purposes of this Determination.
4. Clause 2.2 specifies the additional salary to be paid to parliamentary office holders and includes one change to amend the title of the office of 'Deputy Chairman of Committees in the Senate' to the 'Temporary Chairman of Committees in the Senate'.
