



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Statement: Determination 2010/10 Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Full-Time Public Office

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for certain full-time public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. In making this determination the Tribunal has informed itself through consultation in accordance with established practice.

PART 1 - GENERAL

3. Part 1 specifies the authority for and the date of effect of the Determination and revokes and supersedes the previous principal Determination 2009/18 (as amended) applying to the Offices covered by this Determination. The Part also contains definitions of certain words used in the Determination.

PART 2 – REMUNERATION AND RELATED MATTERS

4. Part 2 provides for an adjustment to Base Salary and Total Remuneration and other related matters (such as personal loadings) effective from 1 August 2010 for the Offices listed in Table 2A. The rates in Determination 2010/10 have been increased by 4.1 per cent (rounded) following a general review of remuneration.
5. Other changes in this Determination from Determination 2009/18 (as amended) relate to changing the order of certain entries in the Tables and attached clauses to take into account amendments made over the life of the previous Determination and to remove or modify the wording of any clauses which no longer have effect.
6. Table 2A – There has been a change of name for three offices associated with the Social Security Appeals Tribunal.

PART 3 - ALLOWANCES

7. Part 3 sets out the allowance provisions. The provisions of this Part are substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2009/18 (as amended).

PART 4 – OFFICIAL TRAVEL

8. Part 4 sets out the entitlements for official travel. The provisions of this Part are substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2009/18 (as amended).

PART 5 – RECREATION LEAVE

9. Part 5 sets out the recreation leave provisions. The provisions of this Part are substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2009/18 (as amended).

PART 6– COMPENSATION FOR EARLY LOSS OF OFFICE

10. Part 6 sets out the provisions for compensation for early loss of office. The provisions of this Part are substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2009/18 (as amended).
