



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2002/17: Remuneration and allowances for various public office holders

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 10 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by replacing the footnote to the reference to the office of 'Australian Submarine Corporation Pty Ltd' with the following:

"The Chair and members of the Australian Submarine Corporation Pty Ltd shall receive pro-rata loadings of \$34,400 and \$8,600 per annum respectively for the period 5 April 2002 until 31 December 2002".

This clause takes effect from 30 June 2002.
- 1.3 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the 'Administrative Review Council', which reads:

"Mr Wayne Martin QC shall receive per diem fees of \$560 in lieu of the annual fee during the period he is engaged as Counsel Assisting the HIH Royal Commission".

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.
- 1.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the 'Employment National', which reads:

"The Chair and Part-Time members of Employment National

shall receive a loading of \$10,000 per annum for the period 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2003”.

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

1.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting “#” after ‘Employment National’. This clause takes effect from 1 July 2002.

1.6 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a third footnote to the reference to the office of the ‘Employment National’, which reads:

“Members who undertake executive duties in respect of Employment National’s Sales Steering Committee and Due Diligence Committee shall receive an additional \$15,000 per annum for the period 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2003”.

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

1.7 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the ‘National Registration Authority for Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals’:

Bankstown Airport Limited, Camden Airport Limited and Hoxton Park Airport Limited	\$35,000	\$20,500	\$18,400	Tier 1
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1.8 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of ‘Bankstown Airport Limited, Camden Airport Limited and Hoxton Park Airport Limited’, which reads:

“These fees only apply to persons who are on the boards of all three companies (Bankstown Airport Limited, Camden Airport Limited and Hoxton Park Airport Limited). The fee is apportioned between the three companies on the basis of 70% Bankstown Airport Limited, 15% Camden Airport Limited and 15% for Hoxton Park Limited. The fees are payable from 1 July 2002”.

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

1.9 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a “#” after ‘Bankstown Airport Limited, Camden Airport Limited and Hoxton Park Airport Limited’. This clause takes effect from 1 July 2002.

1.10 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by replacing the footnote to the reference to the office of

'Australian River Company' with the following:

"Mr EG Anson shall receive additional remuneration of \$37,800 per annum from 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2003, on a pro rata basis, for periods where he has the approval of the Board of the Australian River Company to perform executive duties".

This clause takes effect from 1 July 2002.

- 1.11 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the 'Dairy Adjustment Authority', which reads:

"For the period 27 May 2002 to 31 October 2002 per diem fees will be \$610 and \$460 for the Chair and members respectively".

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.12 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the 'Regional Telecommunications Infrastructure Fund':

Anti-Doping Research Panel	-	\$540	Tier 1
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- 1.13 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the 'Anti-Doping Research Panel', which reads:

"With effect on and from 29 August 2002".

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 2. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 2 should be renumbered sequentially.

PART 2 TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE RATES

- 2.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2000 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.

- 2.2 The Principal Determination is amended by adding Newcastle into its Adelaide, Darwin, Hobart and Canberra Tier 1 heading and adding a footnote which reads:

"Includes Newcastle with effect on and from 1 July 2002".
