



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2002/17

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as defined in sub-sections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of parts of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 10 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clause 1.2 provides pro-rata annual loadings of \$34,400 and \$8,600 for the Chair and members respectively of the Australian Submarine Corporation Pty Ltd for the period 5 April 2002 to 31 December 2002.
5. Clause 1.3 prevents the current Chair of the Administrative Review Council from receiving annual remuneration for this position while he is engaged as Counsel Assisting the HIH Royal Commission. In lieu of annual fee, the Chair will receive per diem fees equal to that of a member of the Council.
6. Clauses 1.4 to 1.6 provide for the following annual loadings for the period 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2003:

Chair, Employment National (EN)	\$10,000
Member, EN	\$10,000
Chair, EN Audit Committee	\$10,000
Member, EN Audit Committee	\$5,000
Member, EN Sales Steering Committee and Due Diligence Committee	\$15,000

7. Clauses 1.7 and 1.8 specify annual remuneration of \$35,000, \$20,500 and \$18,400 for the Chair, Deputy Chair and members respectively of Bankstown Airport Limited, Camden Airport Limited and Hoxton Park Airport Limited and apportion the fees between each company (which have common board membership).
8. Clause 1.9 specifies additional remuneration of \$10,000 and \$5,000 for the Chair and members respectively of the Bankstown Airport Limited, Camden Airport Limited and Hoxton Park Airport Limited Audit Committees.
9. Clause 1.10 extends until 30 June 2003, additional remuneration of \$37,800 per annum for the current Deputy Chair of the Australian River Company.
10. Clause 1.11 provides loadings of \$50 per day for the Chair and members of the Dairy Adjustment Authority for the period 27 May 2002 to 31 October 2002.

11. Clauses 1.12 and 1.13 specify the per diem fees and travel tier for members of the Anti-Doping Research Panel with effect on and from 29 August 2002.

PART 2 TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE RATES

12. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 6 of 2000) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
13. Clause 2.2 adds Newcastle to the Tier 1 travelling allowance rate that incorporates Adelaide, Darwin, Hobart and Canberra with effect from 1 July 2002.
