



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2002/19: Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Public Offices

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1

FULL - TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2001 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that the First Parliamentary Counsel shall be paid a performance bonus of \$13,699 for the period 1 July 2001 to 7 March 2002.

PART 2

PART - TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.3 In this part, Determination Number 10 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.4 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting reference to the office of Commonwealth Child Care Advisory Council.
- 1.5 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following after the reference to the National Health and Medical Research Council, Australian Health Ethics Committee with effect on and from 15 October 2002:

- Expert Advisory Group on Antimicrobial Resistance	\$26,528	-	-	Tier 2
- Special Expert Committee on Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies	\$26,528	-	-	Tier 2
- Gene and Related Therapies Research Advisory Panel	\$26,528	-	-	Tier 2

- 1.6 Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the references of the Expert Advisory Group on Antimicrobial Resistance, the Special Expert Committee on Transmissible Spongiform Encephalopathies, and the Gene and Related Therapies Research Advisory Panel, which reads:

"With effect on and from 15 October 2002."

This footnote will bear the next sequential number to the preceding footnote used in Table 1. After inserting this footnote all remaining footnotes in Table 1 should be renumbered sequentially.

- 1.7 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by substituting the reference of Social Security Appeals Tribunal, Director, to read:

- 1.8 Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new footnote to the reference to the office of the Director, Social Security Appeals Tribunal, which reads:


"With effect on and from 19 November 2002."
