



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2002/22

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 PART - TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 10 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clauses 1.2 and 1.3 increases the annual fee payable to the office of Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee specified in the Principal Determination.
5. Clause 1.4 inserts a footnote in relation to the above mentioned Committee that stipulates that the fee is to be reviewed when the current chairman no longer holds the office.
6. Clause 1.5 inserts a new entry for the Advisory Panel on the Marketing of Infant Formula, setting the annual fee for the Chairman, replacing the previous arrangement of payment of a daily fee.
7. Clause 1.6 inserts a footnote in relation to the above entry that stipulates the date of effect of the new remuneration.
