



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/02

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 FULL - TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 23 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clauses 1.2 and 1.3 reflect an increase in remuneration for the Examiner, Australian Crime Commission.
5. Clause 1.4 amends the Principal Determination to reflect the recent replacement of the National Crime Authority by the Australian Crime Authority.
6. Clause 1.5 amends the Principal Determination to reflect Mr James Bennett's base salary provisions prior to the making of this Determination.
7. Clause 1.6 amends the Principal Determination to list reference clause numbers omitted in amendments made in Determination 2003/01 – *Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Public Offices*.
8. Clause 1.7 provides for clauses 1.2, 1.3, 1.5 and 1.6 to take effect on and from 19 December 2002.

PART 2 PART - TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

9. Clause 1.8 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 10 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
10. Clauses 1.9, 1.10 and 1.11 decrease the annual fee payable to the office of the National Chair, Disability Standards Review Panels with effect from 3 March 2003.
11. Clauses 1.12, 1.13 and 1.14 increase the annual fees payable to the Australian Broadcasting Corporation Board.
12. Clause 1.15 deletes the existing entry of Sydney Airports Corporation Limited as it is no longer owned by the Commonwealth.
