Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/05

Parliamentary office holders – Additional salary

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the additional salary for parliamentary office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*. The Tribunal has decided that no change should be made to the levels of additional salary.

PART A – GENERAL

2. Part A specifies the date of effect of the determination and administration matters. Part A states that this Determination revokes Determination 2002/08 in full.

PART B – ADDITIONAL SALARY AND RELATED MATTERS

3. Part B specifies the basic salary for the purposes of this Determination.
4. Table 1 specifies the additional salary to be paid to parliamentary office holders. Table 1 includes minor changes to correct the titles of some of the parliamentary committees listed and also now includes reference to the House of Representatives Standing Committee of Privileges. Table 1 also clarifies that the leader of a recognised non-government party of at least five members not otherwise specified includes members in either House of the Parliament.
